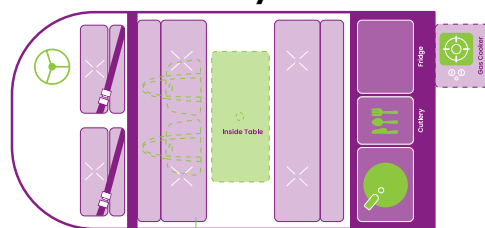

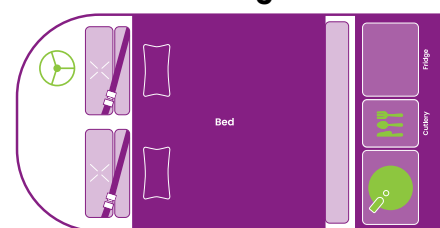
Floor plan

How to use the domestic battery

Your Crib has two batteries – the engine battery keeps the camper running and the domestic battery powers the extras. The domestic battery charges as you are driving along, so you'll need to make sure you don't stay parked up for too long.

- **Lights** – At the rear of the cabin there is an LED strip light that can be turned to face the way that you require!
- **Fridge** – The fridge runs off the domestic battery and has a control panel on the side (Photo 1). On the control panel (Photo 2) we recommend keeping the fridge in the 'Low' power setting as this will preserve the domestic battery level best. You can change the dial to whatever setting you want, but we recommend leaving it on 'cold'!
- **USB/12V Chargers** – You have 2x USB sockets and a 12V car charger slot that run off the domestic battery so you can charge phones and electronics overnight while the engine is off!

NOTE – If you leave the fridge on and the vehicle is stationary for a significant period of time then there is a chance the domestic battery will run flat. Don't Panic though, if you start the engine and start driving the battery should recover its charge!



How to use the gas cooker

- The cooker is designed to be used for very short periods – no longer than 15 minutes at a time
- The cooker is only to be used with the door open in the kitchen or in an outdoor location
- Do not remove the cooker and use in any part of a closed vehicle
- This cooker is not designed for use with pans larger than 200mm

Inserting the cartridge

1. Turn the ignition knob to "OFF" and set the cartridge lever to "UNLOAD". If the ignition knob is not in the "OFF" position, the gas cartridge cannot be loaded.
2. Open the cartridge cover and slide the cartridge, top end first and with the notch up, into the compartment. Align cartridge collar notch with the red indicator tab on the appliance.
3. Push the cartridge lever down to "LOAD" in one firm motion.

Lighting the stove

1. Push and turn the knob anticlockwise past the lightning bolt symbol position until a click is heard.
2. If the burner fails to light, immediately turn the knob to "OFF" position and repeat steps.

To turn off

1. Turn the ignition knob to "OFF" to shut off fuel supply. Wait until the flame is fully extinguished before performing the next step.
2. Raise the cartridge lever to "UNLOAD" and remove the gas cartridge from the compartment.

After use

1. Replace the cap on the gas cartridge after removing it from the unit. Store upright in a cool dry place.
2. Make sure the burner is cool to the touch before packing away.
3. DO NOT store the cartridge near other flammables, sources of heat, or direct sunlight.
4. DO NOT puncture or incinerate empty cartridges.

Note: do not leave the gas cartridge inside the unit when not in use or storing the product.

How to fill & empty the water tanks

There is only one water tank onboard your Crib – a 25L fresh water one. As your grey water does not flow into a tank, the Crib is not considered a self-contained vehicle. This means that you must not camp in Freedom Camping areas.

To fill the fresh water, lift the inlet underneath the fridge and place the green hose in. Turn the tap on and wait for it to fill!

BEWARE – the only way to know that the tank is full is when water starts coming back out of the inlet so don't stand too close and be quick turning the tap off!

How to make the bed

Start from the left sliding door on the passenger side.

1. Undo the fabric toggle on the bench seat.
2. Slide the top cushion back. Here is also where you can access the storage area for your linen and where your interior table leg and top are stored.
3. Fold and push both front seats as far forward as they'll go using the handle underneath on the front.
4. Fold out the remaining bed cushions to fill the whole bed and push the front seats back to lock the bed in place.



Tips & tricks

- **Remember:** Your Crib is NOT self-contained! This means that you must not camp in areas for self-contained vehicles only.
- Always remember to disconnect your butane gas cartridge from the cooker when you are not using it! The lever on the cooker needs to be in the top position so just flick it up when you are done cooking.

Drop-off checklist

Unfortunately all good things must come to an end but hopefully we'll see you again soon! Below is a checklist of the things that we need you to do in your campervan before we say goodbye.

Make sure that the:

- The fuel tank is fully filled
- Dishes and kitchen equipment are left clean
- Empty the grey water tank and the cassette toilet (if your camper has one)
- Interior and exterior of the vehicle are left clean and tidy
- Remember to take all your personal belongings
- If you've pre-arranged after-hours drop-off with our team, drop the key in the drop-off box
