#### **Child and Booster Seat Guide**

01 April 2024 - 31 March 2025







#### Child restraints for all vehicles

All children **aged seven years and under** must travel in an approved child restraint. The type of restraint required for your child depends on their age and size. Guests must refer to the child restraint instruction manual for the appropriate child restraint. Below is a guide:

Child Restraint	Child Seat <sup>1</sup>	Booster Seat <sup>2</sup>	Adult lap-sash seatbelt <sup>3</sup>
Applicable Age Group	0 to 4 years	4 to 7 years	7 years or older (and above 145cm tall)

#### 1. Child Seat

Children aged from birth to four years must travel in an approved, properly fastened and adjusted child seat:

- Children aged under six months must travel in an approved, properly fastened and adjusted, rear-facing child
  restraint. In Australia is recommended children remain rear-facing up to 12 months of age as they cannot turn
  forward-facing until their shoulders reach the entry level height marker on the restraint.
- Children aged between six months and four years must travel in an approved, properly fastened and adjusted, rear-facing child restraint OR a forward-facing child restraint with an in-built harness (the child's shoulders must reach the minimum height marker before facing-forward).

An anchor point is required for this seat.

#### 2. Booster Seat

Children aged **between four years and seven years** must travel in an approved, properly fastened and adjusted, forward-facing child restraint with an in-built harness **OR** an approved booster seat which is properly positioned and fastened with a standard lap-sash seatbelt; whichever one is appropriate for their age and size. A booster seat should be used until the child reaches 145cm tall.

The booster seat provided may feature a top tether strap that needs to be fitted to an anchor point.

#### 3. Adult Lap-Sash Seatbelt

An adult lap-sash seatbelt is designed for people with a **minimum height of 145cm**. A child should continue using a forward-facing restraint or booster seat until they have outgrown it.

#### Hiring a child or booster seat or bringing your own

- · Child seats and booster seats are available for hire from all thi branches for AU\$42 per hire
- · Child/booster seats are included in the Value Pack for each brand
- · Child restraints MUST be pre-booked. Maximum of two child restraints per booking.
- Infant capsules are not available for hire. We supply convertible/reversible child restraints that convert from rear-facing to forward-facing.
- · Vehicles do not feature Isofix fittings
- All child restraints must comply with current Australia/New Zealand Standards and must be labelled AS/NZS 1754
- Child and booster seats brought from overseas do not comply with the Australia/New Zealand standard and it is illegal to use them in Australia
- · It is the responsibility of the driver to fit the seat in the vehicle

#### Where your child can sit

- · A child restraint (child seat or booster seat) can only be fitted on the forward-facing seats in the rear of the vehicle
- The following pages outline which vehicles can have a child restraint fitted and where it can go in each model
- Vehicles fit a maximum of two child restraints of any type (for vehicles where child restraints can be fitted)

#### Please note:

- Front passenger seats cannot accommodate children under seven years, nor children who are over seven years and still in a child restraint
- Child or booster seats are not permitted on the rear facing seats of any vehicle
- The dining table must not be in place whilst driving











