



## SPECIAL ADVICE FOR 4WD CUSTOMERS

We greatly value your safety and patronage. For this reason, we want to ensure all guests renting a 4WD from **thl** are fully aware of key safety considerations. The following points are vital to your safety:

- Always drive within your capability
- Do not make travel times and distances too excessive
- Do not drive at night
- Adjust gear range and tyre pressure to suit conditions
- Observe safety information stickers in vehicle
- If you are tired, take a break
- Stay on the tracks and report remote travel plans to an official or the nearest police station
- Note the vehicle fuel tank size and travel distances, plan ahead and refuel whenever possible
- In case of a breakdown, for your own safety do not leave your vehicle and raise the bonnet up.
- It's advisable to carry 3 - 4L of drinking water per person per day
- Carrying a satellite phone is strongly advised
- EPIRB/PLB should be carried with you when leaving the vehicle
- Be aware of changing road conditions and road closures also tune to local radio stations (sign posted) or check with local authorities

**WRITTEN permission** is required from **thl** to travel into the areas listed below.

Clause 14 on your rental agreement

State/Territory	Restricted
All/Various	Any islands, any remote unsealed roads (not already listed), Simpson Desert, Gunbarrel Highway, Tanami Track, Savannah Way from Normanton to Borroloola, Sandover Highway
Queensland*	Burke Development Road from Chillagoe to Normanton, Cape York between 1 June to 30 November (North of Laura/Cooktown), Bloomfield track
South Australia	Oodnadatta Track, Strzelecki Track, Birdsville Track
Tasmania	Tasmania
Western Australia	Bungle Bungles, Gibb River Road, Kalumburu Road, Mitchell Falls/ Plateau
Northern Territory	Arnhem Land, Larapinta Road between Hermannsburg and Petermann, Plenty Highway, Finke Road (between Alice Springs and Oodnadatta), Chambers Pillar

**We specifically remind you of your responsibilities under clause 25 of your Rental Agreement, this clause informs you when (irrespective of Liability Option taken) you will NOT be covered.**

4WD vehicles are **NOT permitted** in the following areas under any circumstances.

Clause 14 on your rental agreement

State/Territory	Prohibited
All/Various	All beaches, unsealed roads that have not been gazetted, being roads that appear on official road maps and on street directories.
Queensland*	Fraser Island, Moreton Island, Old Telegraph Track section of the road to Cape York, CREB Track, Cape York between 1 December to 31 May, Ghan Heritage Road (from Titjikala to Finkel), Starcke Track, Fenchman Track
Western Australia	Old Gunbarrel Highway, Canning Stock Route
Northern Territory	Boggy Hole (Finke Gorge National Park), Central Arnhem Road (past Beswick), Southern Lost City (Limmen National Park), Old South Road from Maryvale to Finke

### Tyre Pressure

Tyre pressures should be adjusted to suit the terrain you are driving in, the air compressor located in the vehicle has more details on the recommended PSI levels.

### Handy Hints

- Do not leave devices charging in the cab USB port when the vehicle is parked up, as this draws power from the vehicle battery.
- The fridge is powered by the auxiliary battery (not engine battery) & gets a trickle charge while driving for a decent length of time. Stop start driving is not enough to charge the auxiliary battery.
- Carry your satellite phone & EPIRB/PLB with you when you are hiking.

### EPIRB/PLB

- An EPIRB (Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacon or Personal Locator Beacon) or PLB (Personal Locator Beacon) **is designed for use in situations of grave and imminent danger. For example: when there is a life-threatening illness or injury and you have no other means of communication.**
- Deliberate misuse can result in unnecessary deployment of valuable Search & Rescue resources and could incur a severe penalty.
- If accidentally activated, deactivate the device and call 1800 641 792 or int +61 2 6230 6811 to report.

### thl RoadTrip App Handy Hints

- Set up your profile: Select the country you are travelling in “AU”, then the vehicle either “Britz Safari 4WD” or “Britz Outback 4WD” “Britz Maverick” or “Apollo Adventure Camper” or “Cheapa 4WD Camper”
- Some vehicles have “how to” instructional transcripts - you can download these in English, German, French and Chinese while you have wifi/mobile reception, save them to your device so you can then access them later when out of range.
  - Go to “On the Road” > “Help Videos” > then select the language then “share/save to your device”
- You can also download maps to later access ‘offline’
  - Go to the top left corner main menu, select “Offline Map”, while you have wifi/mobile reception, select and download the maps. Then when you are offline, tap the map icon in the top left of the map and select “offline map”, return to “normal” view when you are back in range.
